Privacy Statement

This statement shows how Ireland Vinayaka Temple CLG (IVT) applies the data protection principles to data processed at the temple premises, private Pooja bookings, financial subscriptions which requires greater transparency with regard to your personal information and which gives you greater control on how we use it.

Who we are:

Ireland Vinayaka Temple CLG, is a charitable organisation providing community services having its registered office at Kingswood Community Center, Sylvan Drive, Kingwood, Tallaght, Dublin 24, with registered number CHY16032

General Statement

This statement outlines how we protect and manage personal data. For certain private devotional services provided by IVT additional IVT terms and conditions will apply. While utilizing these services, IVT Terms and Conditions will require to be adhered and a copy of these terms and conditions are generally sent as part of administrative activity.

We fully respect your right to privacy, any personal information which you volunteer to provide to IVT for the purpose of devotional/community services and also for subscriptions/Donations made to IVT. Your data will be treated with the highest standards of security and confidentiality.

While registering with IVT for receiving communications or request for services or for donation purposes, you agree to provide your personal information. You have a number of rights in relation to your information including right to object, publishing on IVT website, or sending communications or in correspondence with you on various services. In order for us to maintain the accurate information please inform us for any updated information, if your information is already registered with us.

General Information we collect from you.

As defined in GDPR, personal information is any information relating to identifiable person who can directly or indirectly be identifiable. IVT collect the following information during its activities.

- 1) Name
- 2) Address
- 3) Telephone Contact
- 4) Email Id

- 5) Transaction information
- 6) Any other personal information as per requirements of Hindu Cultural and Devotional services.
- 7) Photography/Video information
- 8) Information through Social media

As IVT is a charitable organisation IVT is eligible for certain clawback schemes extended by Irish Revenue. IVT may collect additional information/data as per Revenue requirements with your consent.

Sensitive information

In general we do not collect any sensitive information unless it is volunteered by you for the specific purpose as requested by IVT or any legal body where IVT requires to provide such information.

Information from Online Activities.

IVT will do certain online financial/registration transactions for the purpose of providing services and do not collect or store any cookies information other than the data collected by the website service provider for the purpose of any technical evaluation. For IVT activities, Information collected will be limited to the General personal information as outlined above.

Personal Information from Children

IVT do not collect or transact any information from Children <18 years old and unless supervised and accompanied by an adult during any of its activity or services.

Personal data you give about others

You should only provide the information about other people if you have permission to do so. It will be responsibility of you that the person is aware of such information is shared with IVT and has accepted to use his information by IVT

When we collect the Data and Use it

We use your personal information while you are making a booking for the services or sponsoring a service during a devotional activities conducted by IVT. In certain times, if the required information is not provided then we may not facilitate the service. In this case, IVT may contact you directly based on information provided by you. We administer the bookings while using your personal information collected.

We use your personal information on sending monthly emails or provide updates on activities we conduct regularly. If you do not wish to receive such email you may opt to come out of the mails and request for deletion of your personal data for sending such emails. You can make such requests by sending an email to feedback@ivit.ie

We use your name and other personal data as transaction information for the purpose of maintaining the financial data consolidation as per Ireland accounting practises and regulatory requirements. If you wish you do not want make such personal information to be disclosed on IVT website or through any other communications, you may make such request by sending an email to feedback@ivit.ie.

We use your personal information while you are making bookings or payments using online services available within IVT.

While operating at the centre, we may seek your personal information for you to register with IVT. With your consent only, we will take your personal information and by providing information, you are providing your consent for IVT to use your personal information for its activities. If you wish you unsubscribe from these communications and would like IVT to delete your personal information, you may send an email to feedback@ivt.ie for such requests

Fraud Detection and Prevention

We may use your personal information for any Fraud detection or prevention of any illegal or fraudulent activities

Collected Data from other Sources

On certain occasions, we may use other groups to promote or support IVT activities and under these circumstances, we may collect your data for the purposes as it is necessary. We may combine this information with the available information and use for the purposes as outlined in our Privacy statement.

Analytical Purposes

From time to time, we may take feedback from you or use your personal information to improve the activities provided

Who we share information

IVT commitment is to protect your privacy. We protect your information from any unauthorized use or loss or only pass your data to do IVT activities as deemed necessary to fulfil your requirements, improve services or where required by Law. IVT uses its employee to provide majority of the services and the committee/volunteers or board members of IVT may share your personal data in good faith while protecting your personal privacy that such disclosure is authorized by Law or to protect your personal safety. If we are requested to provide your personal information by a third-party, we will use reasonable efforts to notify you in advance of any such disclosure unless legally prohibited.

Security and Retention Procedures

IVT has reasonable systems in place to retain your data and the retention policy is to keep your personal information as long as necessary. This is to comply with applicable laws, resolve disputes, or otherwise necessary to conduct IVT activities. All personal data retained will be subject to this Privacy statement.
